

CHAPTER 118.

AN ACT supplementary to an Act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter two, restricting the power of the County Commissioners of Frederick county, in issuing the bonds of the county in aid of Turnpike companies.

Duty of
County Com-
missioners.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Frederick county shall not be authorized to issue any bonds or credit of the county, or subscribe to any turnpike company, as authorized by the Act of eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter two, until the Board of Stockholders of said company shall first have filed a statement under oath, in the office of the said Commissioners, that the total amount of three-fifths, subscribed for by private stockholders as provided by the Act of eighteen hundred seventy, chapter two, has been fully and entirely paid up.

In force.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 119.

AN ACT to amend the Charter of the Union Railroad Company of Baltimore, and to give additional powers to said company.

Authorized
to increase
capital stock.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the President and Directors of the Union Railroad Company of Baltimore, or a majority of them, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, from time to time, to increase the capital stock of said company by an amount not exceeding, in the aggregate, the sum of six hundred thousand dollars, and to make the whole or any part of such
