

more eligible positions or locations, and whenever a new road shall be opened as a public highway in either of said counties, the Supervisor of the district shall cause all gates to be removed therefrom.

Penalty for violating.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That any person who shall violate the provisions of the preceding sections of this Act, shall pay a fine of twenty dollars, to be recovered by action of debt, before a Justice of the Peace, in the name of the County Commissioners, to be applied to the road fund of the county; and any Supervisor, who shall fail or neglect to perform his duties under the provisions of this Act, shall forfeit and pay a fine of twenty dollars, to be recovered in the same manner and applied to said fund.

CHAPTER 162.

AN ACT to repeal section seventeen of article ninety-six, of the Code of Public General Laws, title Weights and Measures, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section seventeen of article ninety-six, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Weights and Measures," be and the same is hereby

Re-enacted.

repealed and re-enacted, as follows:

Oats, measure of or weight.

SEC. 17. Oats shall be bought and sold in this State by struck measure or by weight, at the rate of twenty-six pounds to the bushel.

In force.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
