CHAPTER 175.

AN ACT to repeal the forty-third, forty-fourth, forty-sixth, and seventy-third sections of article ten of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, relating to the town of Cambridge, in Dorchester county, and to re-enact the same in an amended form.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Repealed. Maryland, That the forty-third, forty-fourth, forty-sixth, and seventy-third sections of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, relating to the town of Cambridge, in Dorchester county, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as Re-enacted. follows:

- 43. The Commissioners may make such by-laws Makeby-laws not contrary to law, for the regulation and good government of said town and the inhabitants thereof, and to restrain all disorders and disturbances, and prevent and remove all nuisances, inconveniences and annoyances within said town; to prevent the running of horses, cattle, and other stock, and firing Prevent catof guns, pistols and fire-crackers in the streets, lanes ning at large. or alleys, the burning of chimneys in dry weather, the continuance of unsafe chimneys, stoves or stovepipes; to make, repair, and regulate footways, to make and keep open drains or sewers, to extend the streets or alleys, and renew their boundaries, to regulate market days, and such other things as they may deem proper; and may enforce obedience to Enforce their by-laws by such fines, penalties and forfeitures as they may deem reasonable, not exceeding twenty dollars for any one offence.

They may cause an assessment to be made May cause from time to time, by some person by them appointed, assessment to of all the property, real, personal and mixed, of all be made. kinds and descriptions whatsoever, within the corporate limits of the town of Cambridge, or owned by the inhabitants of said town and not permanently located beyond the limits thereof, liable by law to be valued and assessed and chargeable with taxes in this State,
