what kind, nature or quantity soever, and to borrow money for corporate purposes or uses, not exceeding in the aggregate ten thousand dollars, and to mortgage the property of the said company for that purpose, and do all other acts necessary for carrying into effect the object of this Act of Assembly, and the same to grant and dispose of, to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, in any Court of record, or any place whatsoever, to make and use a common seal, and the same to alter at pleasure, and also to ordain, establish, and put in execution such by-laws and regulations as shall seem necessary and convenient for the government of the said corporation and the management of its affairs; provided the same be Proviso. not repugnant to the laws and Constitution of the State of Maryland or of the United States.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That whenever shares to Call a gener'l the extent of at least one-fifth of said capital stock meeting. shall have been subscribed, the said company shall call a general meeting of said subscribers in the City of Westminster at such place as they may determine, and a majority of those at said meeting shall be emmajority may powered to elect a President and seven Directors, being elect Presid't stockholders, to manage the affairs of the company for one year and until a new election shall be held, in the manner directed by the by-laws of the company and that every subscriber, at all meetings the company, shall be entitled to one vote for every share he, she, it or they may own.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That the said President Duties of and Directors shall appoint the time and place and President and direct the manner of holding the election for President and Directors. dent and Directors which shall be annual, may provide for calling general meetings of the stockholders, the mode of transferring the stock of said company, and of reasonable proof of ownership therein for that purpose, and may have authority to fix the amount of toll to be paid by persons using or passing along said road; not exceeding two cents per mile for each and every mile traveled on said road, by each and every horse, head of cattle, chaise, wagon, carriage, buggy, &c.
