Sec. 10. And be it enacted, That if any person or persons whosoever, riding, driving or leading any animal or thing for which tolls are prescribed by this Act, shall pass through any private gate or bar passageway, or other ground, with the intent to defraud the said company, and avoid the payment of the toll or duty for passing through any of its gates or turnpikes, such person or persons in all or any of the ways or means so offending, shall for every such offence, respectively forfeit and pay to said company, any sum not less than ten dollars, nor more than twenty dollars, to be sued for and recovered with costs of suit, before any Justice of the Peace, in like marner
