CHAPTER 227.

AN ACT to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland, to the bequest of Joseph Waltman, late of Frederick county, deceased, to the Trustees of the Evangelical Lutheran Congregation, worshipping at New Jerusalem Meeting House, near Lovettsville in the County of Loudon, and State of Virginia, or to the Treasurer thereof, and legalizing the same.
