Act to be advertised.

SEC. 12. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall be advertised in the newspaper or newspapers published in Calvert county for two months preceding the next election to be held for members of the House of Delegates, and be subject to the approval of a majority of all the members elected to each House of the General Assembly of Maryland at its next session after said election.

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#### CHAPTER 243.

AN ACT to repeal sections thirty-three and thirty-four, of chapter three hundred and sixty-four, of Acts passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled, "Oysters," and to re-enact the following in lieu thereof, changing the style of the Oyster Police Board, and making the Commissioner of the Land Office one of said Board.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections thirty-three and thirty-four, of chapter three hundred and sixty-four, of Acts passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled, "Oysters," be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof:
