to be appropriated by the Conptroller in proportion to the number of colored inhabitants in each county and Baltimore city, between the ages of six and twenty-one years, fifty thousand dollars; for donations to colleges, academies and schools, thirty-one thousand five hundred dollars, as per Acts and resolutions heretofore passed; to the Saints John's College, twelve thousand dollars; provided, that none of the appropriations to colleges, academies and schools shall be paid to any such institution unless such institution shall have, before the twentieth day of January, eighteen hundred and seventy-three, made a full report, as required by law; to the Deaf and Dumb Asylum at Frederick, twenty-five thousand dollars, for the eduction of the deaf and dumb; to the Maryland Institute for the promotion of Mechanics' Arts, three thousand dollars, as provided by Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter one hundred and ninety-eight; to Colored Normal School two thousand dollars, and for the Maryland Agricultural College, the sum of six thousand dollars.

Proviso.

Treasurer to disburse.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the Treasurer of this State shall, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, disburse the said sums of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons, bodies politic or corporate, severally entitled thereto; and that the several public officers to whom the same or any part thereof may be paid, shall render quarterly, to the Comptroller, accounts of the expenditures thereof, with the proper vouchers thereof, verified by affidavit.

In force.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and seventy-three.
