

CHAPTER 259.

AN ACT to repeal chapter seventy-five, of article twenty-one, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Fish," passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows :

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Repealed. That chapter seventy-five, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Fish," be and the same is hereby Re-enacted. repealed, and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

SUB-SEC. 1. No person or persons shall hereafter Not to fish fish in the waters of Israel Creek, in Washington with stir-net, county, with stir-net, gig or lance, from the date of gig or lance. the passage of this Act until the first day of April, eighteen hundred and seventy-four.

SUB-SEC. 2. Any person or persons violating the Penalty for preceding section shall pay a fine of five dollars for violating. each and every offence, to be recovered before a Justice of the Peace of said county, one-half of which shall be paid to the School Commissioners of Washington county for the use of the Public Schools, and the other half to the informer.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.
