CHAPTER 259.

AN ACT to repeal chapter seventy-five, of article twenty-one, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Fish," passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows:

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Repealed. Maryland, That chapter seventy-five, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Fish," be and the same is hereby Re-enacted. repealed, and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

SUB-SEC. 1. No person or persons shall hereafter Not to fish fish in the waters of Israel Creek, in Washington with stir-net, county, with stir-net, gig or lance, from the date of gig or lance, the passage of this Act until the first day of April, eighteen hundred and seventy-four.

SUB-SEC. 2. Any person or persons violating the Penalty for preceding section shall pay a fine of five dollars for violating. each and every offence, to be recovered before a Justice of the Peace of said county, one-half of which shall be paid to the School Commissioners of Washington county for the use of the Public Schools, and the other half to the informer.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.
