

CHAPTER 260.

AN ACT to repeal section thirty-eight of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's County," sub-title "Bladensburg," and to enact in lieu thereof the following section :

Repealed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section thirty-eight of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's County," sub-title "Bladensburg," passed by the General Assembly and approved March thirtieth, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, be and the same is hereby repealed, and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Appoint Commissioners for Bladensburg. SEC. 38. *And be it enacted,* That the County Commissioners of Prince George's county shall, at their first meeting in the month of April next, and annually thereafter, appoint five commissioners for the village of Bladensburg, who shall be substantial citizens, residents within said corporate limits for at least two years next preceding their appointment, and continue to reside therein during their continuance in office, to serve for one year from the date of their appointment, and until their successors are appointed and qualified; and said commissioners so appointed shall appoint a bailiff or collector, whose duty it shall be to collect all taxes; and if any citizen, from whom taxes are due within said corporate limits, shall fail or refuse to pay the same on or before the first day of June succeeding such assessment, such taxes may be collected by way of distress as between landlord and tenant, and the same fees allowed as in the case of such remedy by distress.

Repealed. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all laws inconsistent with this Act be and the same are hereby repealed.

In force. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
