Sec. 49. Be it enacted, That the County Treasurer Office hours shall keep in the court house building, in the town of Treasurer. of Upper Marlboro, his office open from ten o'clock in the forenoon until three o'clock in the afternoon, three days in each and every week, to be by him designated, for the purpose of receiving State and county taxes, and disbursing same as directed by law, and shall also attend in person or by deputy in Attend each each election district of said county two days between trict. the date of each annual levy and the first day of October thereafter, at such place and time as he may appoint, for the purpose of collecting said taxes; and he shall give notice by advertisement in one paper published in said county, and by notice posted up in three public places in each election district of said county, in hand-bill form, of the time and place where he will be in each of said districts for collect. To give noing and receiving the same, notifying all those who tice of time. owe county taxes that if they are paid to him on or before the first day of July and the first day of October, they will be entitled to a deduction of eight or four per centum, according as they are paid, on or before the respective dates hereinbefore mentioned, and after the Treasurer has given the notices by public advertisement, as directed by this section, and complied with provisions of this Act, all those who fail to pay their State and county taxes on or before the said taxes are due and in arrear, as prescribed by law, it shall only be necessary for him to levy upon the real or personal property within the limits of To levy on Prince George's county, of any delinquent, and after property of giving at least twenty days' notice of the time, terms delinquent and place of sale, by advertisement in at least one only. newspaper published in said county, shall, on the premises or at the court house door of said county, proceed to sell, by public auction, the property so levied on for cash to the highest bidder, retaining
