SEC. 50. *And be it enacted*, That the said Treasurer shall keep and pay over, according to law or order of the County Commissioners, the proceeds of all county taxes levied in said county and collected by him, and also keep and pay over to the Treasurer of the State of Maryland, according to law, all the State taxes levied in said county and collected by him; and he shall keep a full, particular and correct account of all moneys received by him and paid out, and of all matters relating to the duties of his office, together with all vouchers relating thereto; he shall, when required, present to the County Commissioners a true and faithful exhibit of all moneys received by him and of all that have been paid out by him.

## CHAPTER 295.

AN ACT to add additional *section* to the Code of Public Local Laws, article three, title " Baltimore county," in relation to trespass.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, many idle and disorderly persons, under pretence of hunting and fowling, trespass with dogs and guns upon the land of persons residing in Baltimore county, and especially adjacent to the City of Baltimore, frequently shooting small insectivorous
