to a penalty of not less than ten nor more than thirty dollars, one-third to the informer, one-third to the constable who may make the arrest, and the balance to be paid to the Treasurer of the Board of County School Commissioners for school purposes; provided, that any person or persons so of-Proviso. fending, on conviction thereof as aforesaid, who shall refuse or fail to pay said fine imposed, and the costs thereon, such person or persons shall be imprisoned in the county jail of the county aforesaid for not less than ten nor more than twenty days.

- SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty Duty of Conof any constable to whose attention a violation of stable. the provisions of this Act is called, at once to report the same to a Justice of the Peace, and upon warrant * issued, to arrest the offender or offenders and bring him or them before said Justice for trial; and any constable who fails so to report a case of offence, Failure to rewith the name of the informer, under this Act, when notified as aforesaid, shall himself be liable to a penalty of ten dollars, to be recoverable as like penalties are now by law recoverable.
- SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That upon the failure to Costs to be establish the guilt of any person or persons charged paid by with violating the provisions of this Act, all costs original inshall be paid by the original informer, or the accused, or both of them, at the discretion of the Justice.
- SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That any person or per-Party sons who may feel himself or themselves aggrieved aggrieved by any judgment rendered by a Justice of the Peace, under the provisions of this Act, shall have the right to appeal to the Circuit Court for Frederick county, upon the conditions and subject to the regulations now provided by the general law regulating appeals from Justices of the Peace; but execution of the Execution judgment of the Justice of the Peace shall not be not to be stayed, unless the party appealing shall give bond to the State for double the amount of the fine imposed, with security approved by the Justice rendering the judgment, with condition to prosecute his appeal with effect, or to pay the fine imposed with all costs.
