CHAPTER 321.

AN ACT to refund to George W. Oldham, of Cecil county, a certain sum of money erroneously paid into the Treasury.

Appropriat'n to pay Geo. W. Oldham.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and directed, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to pay to George W. Oldham, of Cecil county, the sum of twenty-four dollars and ninety-three cents, being the sum by which the said George W. Oldham has overpaid his account as collector of State taxes for the ninth district of Cecil county, for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-eight.

CHAPTER 322.

AN ACT to prevent the enclosing and obstructing the streets, lanes and alleys in the town of Franklin, in Baltimore county, and to prevent nuisances, &c.

Not lawful to Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of enclose streets, &c. Maryland, That from and after the passage of this
