

CHAPTER 343.

AN ACT to approve and confirm an ordinance of the City of Baltimore, approved on the twenty-fourth day of June, eighteen hundred and seventy-one, entitled "an ordinance to condemn and close McEldery street between Register and Wolfe streets, and Ann street between Jefferson and Monument streets, and all streets, lanes and alleys comprised within the whole grounds bounded on the north by Monument street, on the south by Jefferson street, on the east by Wolfe street, and on the west by Register street."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the ordinance of the City Council of Baltimore, approved on the twenty-fourth day of June, eighteen hundred and seventy-one, entitled "an ordinance to condemn and close McEldery street between Register and Wolfe streets, and Ann street between [between] Jefferson and Monument streets, and all streets, lanes or alleys comprised within the whole grounds, bounded on the north by Monument street, on the south by Jefferson street, on the east by Wolfe street, and on the west by Register street," be and the same is hereby approved and confirmed, and the said streets closed by said ordinance, shall remain closed so long as the property included in the said bounds shall be used for the purpose of an hospital.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
