

## CHAPTER 351.

AN ACT to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of John Coates, late of Baltimore city, deceased, to the Sabbath School attached to the Methodist Protestant Church, at the corner of Lombard and Green streets, in the City of Baltimore.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, John Coates, late of Baltimore city, deceased, by his last will and testament, duly admitted to probate and recorded in the Office of the Register of Wills of said city, bequeathed unto the Sabbath School attached to the Methodist Protestant Church, at the corner of Lombard and Green streets, in said City of Baltimore, from and after the death of his wife, Lucretia Coates, the sum of three thousand dollars, the interest of which is intended to supply said Sabbath School with a good and sufficient library yearly, and for no other purpose, therefore,

Sanction given to bequest.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given and declared to the above mentioned bequest, by the said John Coates, deceased.

In force.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
