CHAPTER 358.

AN ACT to provide for the appointment of an additional Justice of the Peace for Election District number three, in Harford county.

To appoint additional Justice of the Peace. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint an additional Justice of the Peace for Election District, number three, in Harford county.

In force. SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 359.

AN ACT to give to the *tongsman* in Queen Anne's and Kent counties the right to take or catch oysters in the waters of either county, on a license to be taken out in the county in which the tongsman respectively *reside*.

Tongsmen allowed to catch oysters SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That any resident of either Queen Anne's or Kent county, owning or having in his possession
