

For Berlin Election District, number three, the Number same boundaries as are now established by law, shall <sup>three.</sup> continue to be the limits of said district number three.

For Newark Election District, number four, the Number same boundaries as are now established by law, shall continue to be the limits of said district number four.

For Saint Martin's Election District, number five, Number the same boundaries as are now established by law, shall continue to be the limits of said district number five.

For Colbourne's Election District, number six, the Number same boundaries heretofore established by law, in so far as they do not conflict with the election districts of Wicomico county, or the territory of said county, shall be the limits of said district number six, except such other additional territory as by this Act may be included therein.

For Atkinson's Election District, number seven, Number the same boundaries as are now established by law, <sup>seven.</sup> in so far as they do not conflict with the election districts of Wicomico county, or the territory of said county, shall be the limits of said district number seven, except such other additional territory as by this Act may be included therein.

For Stockton Election District, number eight; the Number following shall be the boundaries of said district, <sup>eight.</sup> namely: all the territory north and east of line in the said forty-first section of this Act mentioned, beginning on the Pocomoke River at Cottingham's Ferry, and running by and with the county road leading from said ferry, to the county road leading from Snow Hill to Newtown, by way of Davis' Cross Roads; thence by and with the county road to a place known by the name of the "Sheep House," and thence in a direct course by survey to the line to the State of Virginia.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take <sup>In force.</sup> effect from the date of its passage.
