ments of said corporation, but that the money, property, rights and credits of said corporation, and nothing more, shall be liable for the same.

Elect members. SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the directors of said corporation, or a majority of them, attending any meeting of the board, may elect, by ballot, any other person or persons as member or members of the said corporation.

Sinking fund

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That one-fifth of the net earnings of the said corporation shall be annually set apart and reserved as a sinking fund for the security of the depositors.

In force.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

AN ACT authorizing and directing the State Librarian to furnish from the State Library, for the use of the Circuit Court for Washington county, a full set of the decisions of the Court of Appeals and of the Acts of Assembly, and other books.

State Libr arian to furnish books. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the State Librarian be and he is hereby authorized and directed to furnish from the copies on hand in the library, for the use of the Circuit Court for Washington county, a full set of the reports of the decisions of the Court of Appeals, and of the Acts of Assembly, indexes, &c., and a copy of the several digests of the Code and its supplements, Evans' Practice, Barroll's Chancery Practice, Bland's Chancery Reports, Maryland Chancery Decisions, Digest of the decisions construing the Statutes of Maryland, and Alexander's British Stat-
