CHAPTER 439.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay John Feast for labor done and materials furnished in improving the grounds within the enclosure of the Governor's Mansion.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of five hundred and fifteen dollars and seventy cents be and the same is hereby appropriated to pay John Feast for labor done and materials furnished in improving the grounds within the enclosure of the Governor's Mansion, and the Comptroller is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the [the] Treasurer, payable to the order of John Feast, for the same.
