tion, or to cut a channel through the same, and otherwise to improve the navigation of the harbor of Annapolis.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, it is represented that the building used as a Post Office in the City of Annapolis is unsuited for that purpose, and that no other can be procured to be adapted for such use; and

Preamble.

Whereas, the rents now paid for the Post Office building, the Internal Revenue office for this district and for the Custom House, amount to a considerable sum, without adequate accommodations for these officers, and it is deemed a measure of economy that a building be erected for the use of the officers above-named; therefore,

Erection of a building.

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Senators and Representatives in Congress for this State, be and they are hereby requested to bring this subject to the attention of Congress, and use their efforts to procure an appropriation for the erection of a building suitable to the purposes above indicated.

Transmit copy.

Resolved, That the Governor be and he is hereby requested to transmit to our Senators and Representatives in Congress copies of this resolution, to be laid before the Senate and House of Representatives.
