Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That our Senators and Representatives in the Congress of ^{Cutting an} the United States be requested to use their efforts to ^{inlet.} procure the passage of a law authorizing the employment of an engineer to ascertain, the cost and practicability of cutting an inlet or channel from the Atlantic Ocean into the waters of Synepuxent Bay, through the beach opposite the coast of Worcester county, in the interest of the commerce of the county, and for the purpose of affording a secure and convenient harbor for our shipping, and a place of refuge from the storms, by which great numbers of vessels are stranded on our coast.
