A bill, entitled an Act to repeal chapter 441, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January Session, 1870.

A bill, entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Article XXXVIII., section 1, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Fees of Officers," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Roach, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill, entitled an Act to add the following sections to Article XIX. of the Code of Public Local Laws of Somerset county, sub-title "Retailers," and to be sections 149, 150, 151, 152, 153, 154, 155, 156, 157 and 158.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Baldwin, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

The Senate bill, entitled an Act to repeal, amend and re-enact section 7, of Article XII. of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Harford County," sub-title "Almshouse."
