A bill, entitled an Act amendatory of an Act passed at December Session, 1849, chapter 358, entitled an Act incorporating the Union Plank or Turnpike Road Company in Montgomery county.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Radcliffe, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill, entitled an Act to add additional sections to Article X., of Public Local Laws, entitled "Dorchester County," sub-title "Riparian Rights for the protection of Riparian Proprietors in Dorchester County."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Bond, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably,

A bill, entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Calvert county to re-district or increase the number of election precincts in said county.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Rutzahn, Chairman of a Select Committee, to whom was referred

The bill, entitled an Act to add additional sections to Article XI. of the Code of Public Local Laws of Frederick county, relating to the powers and duties of the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick, to follow section 177, added thereto by the Act of 1870, chapter 314,

Reported back the same without amendments.

Said bill was then read a first time.

Mr. Polk, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably

The Senate bill, entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Union Bridge in Carroll county.

Which was read a second time.

On motion of Mr. Bond, (the rules being suspended,)

The House proceeded to the consideration of bills entitled to a third reading.

The bill, entitled an Act to regulate the Inspection of Tobacco.

Was then read a third time and passed by yeas and nays, as follows :
