The further consideration thereof was postponed, and The bill referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Hon. Jno. Thomson Mason, Secretary of State, delivered the following message, from His Excellency, the the Governor:

Executive Department, Annapolis, Feb. 14, 1872.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates:

I have approved and signed the following bills received from your Honorable Body, and have transmitted to the Clerk of the Court of Appeals, in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution, viz:

An Act to complete the Somerset and Worcester Railroad. Also,

An Act to alter and amend sections 193, 194, 195, 196, 197, 198, 199, of Article I., of the supplement of 1870 to the Code of Public Local Laws, under the head of "Allegany county," relating to birds, and to re-enact the same with amendments, so as to read, respectively, as follows.

Also,

An Act relating to fences in Wicomico county.

Also,
