Which was read, and referred to the Dorchester delegation.

Leave was granted the Frederick delegation to introduce a bill, entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Frederick county to make an appropriation for the purpose of constructing fish ways in the Monocacy river.

On motion of Mr. Scott,

Leave was granted the Prince George's delegation to introduce a bill, to repeal section 38 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's county." sub-title "Bladensburg," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

On motion of Mr. Routzahn,

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill, entitled an Act to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of Joseph Waltman, late of Frederick county, deceased, to the trustees of the Evangelical Lutheran Congregation, at New Jerusalem, near Lorettsville, in the county of London and State of Virginia, or the Treasurer thereof, and legalizing the same.

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill to continue in force the Acts of Assembly relating to fees of Constables and Justices of the Peace.
