

The Senate bill, entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, section 24, of Article XCIV., title "Treasurer," of the Code of Public General Laws,

Reported back the same with proposed amendment.

AMENDMENT PROPOSED :

Section 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

The amendment was adopted,

And the bill, as amended, read a second time.

Also,

The Senate bill, entitled an Act to repeal section 93, of Article LXXXI., of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Revenue and Taxes," and to enact the following section in lieu thereof, reported back the same with proposed amendment.

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Strike out all of section 1, after the word "State," in line 23.

The amendment was adopted, and the bill, as amended, was read a second time.

A bill, entitled an Act to prevent stock running at large in and around Waverly, in Baltimore county.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. H. H. Lamotte, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably, —

A bill, entitled an Act to extend the civil jurisdiction of Justices of the Peace for Carroll county.
