AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 12, after the words, "And be it enacted," strike out the balance of said section and insert the following: That the County Commissioners aforesaid shall have the bonds as aforesaid printed, and shall pay for the said printing out of the fund appropriated to the building of the said Court House, all their necessary and legitimate expenses incurred in the discharge of the duties imposed by this Act; and that the compensation, beyond actual expenses, shall not exceed one hundred dollars for each of said Commissioners.
