

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the Church of God at Fair-Play, Washington county.

Leave was granted the Prince George's delegation to introduce a bill to tax dogs and to protect sheep in Prince George's county.

Leave was granted to the Harford delegation to introduce a bill to repeal sections 25 and 26 of the Code of Public Local Laws, Article XII, title "Harford County," and to re-enact the same with amendments, authorizing the appointment or election of a County Treasurer.
