The bill, entitled an Act to repeal chapter 456, of the Acts of 1870, entitled an Act to prohibit stock running at large in and around Pikesville, in Baltimore county,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill, entitled an Act to refund to George W. Oldham, of Cecil county, a certain sum of money erroneously paid into the Treasury,
