## AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

At the end of section 1, add the following provise: Provided, nothing in this Act shall be construed to prevent the aforesaid Clerk from granting license to any person or persons now selling fermented liquors, or lager beer, within the aforesaid prescribed limits.

Which was adopted.

The bill as amended was then read a third time, and rejected for want of a Constitutional majority by yeas and nays, as follows:
