The bill entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Continental Fire and Marine Insurance Company of Baltimore, to change the corporate name, and to cure certain irregularities in the original organization thereof.

The bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article LXXXI. of the Code of Public General Laws of this State, title "Revenue and Taxes," under the sub-title "Assessment of Stock for State Purposes."

Also, returned the following bills:

Severally endorsed, "Reported unfavorably from the Committee on Finance, and the report adopted."

The bill entitled an Act to provide for a new assessment of the property of the Free Stone Mining and Manufacturing Company of Montgomery county.

A bill, entitled an Act to exempt the Second Election District of Baltimore county from the operation of chapter 265 of the Code of Public Local Laws, passed January Session, 1870, relating to swine running at large.
