AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Strike out all after the enacting clause, and insert the following sections :

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, at any time, to shoot, or otherwise to kill or injure, or pursue with such intent, any of the following named birds within the limits of Frederick county, viz: Robins, bluebirds, thrushes, martins, swallows, larks, orioles, redbirds, catbirds, sparrows, whippoorwils, wrens, peewits, gold finches, sapsuckers, or woodpeckers; *Provided*, that nothing contained in this Act shall be so construed to prevent the killing or capture of crows, blackbirds or birds of prey.

Section 2. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be unlawful for any person, knowingly and unnecessarily to destroy or disturb the eggs of any of the birds protected by the provisions of this Act.
