The bill, entitled an Act to repeal section 24, of the Act of January Session, 1870, chapter 476, entitled an Act to provide for the creation and regulation of incorporated companies in the State of Maryland, and to re-enact the same with amendments, giving additional powers to railroad companies incorporated by this State.
