The bill, entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Loudon Park Cemetery Company of Baltimore County, so as to enable it to acquire land in Baltimore county, in addition to the quantity which it may now hold,

The bill, entitled an Act to incorporate the Enterprise Avenue Company, of Baltimore county,

Was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill, entitled an Act to amend the Act passed at the January Session, 1868, chapter 431, incorporating the Frederick and Williamsport Railroad Company,

Was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill, entitled an Act to make valid the erection of a town hall, &c., over the market house, in the town of Easton, by the Easton Town Hall Company, and to authorize the Commissioners of said town to lease the same to said Company,

Was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
