The further consideration thereof was postponed, and the bill referred to the Allegany delegation.

The Senate bill, entitled an Act to authorize the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown to appropriate a sum of money to purchase a hook and ladder apparatus, to aid and assist the fire department of Hagerstown, and to levy a tax for the payment of the same.

Was read a third time and passed by yeas and nays, as follows :
