A bill entitled an Act to repeal sub-section 941, passed January Session, 1870, relating to Baltimore county.

A bill, entitled an Act to forbid a member of the General Assembly of Maryland, or other officers of the State holding any other State office of profit or trust created, or to be created by the Governor and General Assembly, or by any law relating to the State of Maryland, and to forbid his being interested directly, or indirectly, in any contract to which the State is a party.

A bill, entitled an Act to prevent the enclosing and other obstructing the streets, lanes and alleys in the town of Franklin, in Baltimore county.

REPORT.

The Committee to whom was referred an order of the House of delegates, to ascertain whether it consists with the official oath taken by a member of the General Assembly of Maryland for him to be interested in the profits of the printing contract, and whether it is sound public policy for any member of either branch of the General Assembly, to be interested in any contract made by the Body of which he is, at the time thereof, a member, and also to ascertain how the accounts for printing are settled, how audited, and by what
