A bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 86, 95, 103, 104, 105, 117, 118, 119, 120, 121, 124, 127, 128 and 129, of Article IV. of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore City," sub-title "Auctions," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
