Which was adopted.

The bill as amended was then read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The House then proceeded to the consideration of the bill entitled an Act to tax the gross receipts of railroad companies in this State, for State purposes.

Said bill being upon a second reading,

Mr. Stone submitted the following amendment.

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 1, line 3, after the word "companies," insert the words "worked by steam."

Which was adopted.

The bill, as amended, was then read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The House then proceeded to the consideration of the next order of the day.

Being the bill entitled an Act to provide for the collection of arrearages of State Taxes due on the shares of capital stock of National Banks, and Banking Associations, located in this State, and doing business therein,

Said bill being upon a third reading,
