The bill entitled an Act to protect Fish in the waters of the Nanticoke River, from non-residents,

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on the Chesapeake Bay and its Tributaries.

The bill entitled an Act to release Stephen J. Bradley, Samuel Phillips and D. Washington Finley, administrator of Lemuel Roberts, securities on the Bond of Noah C. Merchant, late Collector of State and County taxes, in the First Election District of Queen Anne's county, for the years 1867 and 1868, from the payment of interest on their payment of balance of principal due on the State bond of said Merchant, into the Treasury of the State, by the 15th day of December, 1872,
