The bill entitled an Act to amend and re-enact section 8 of Public Local Laws, passed February 16th, 1864, chapter 96, and the supplement thereto, section 3, chapter 27 of the Code of Public Local Laws, passed February 18th, 1868, entitled an Act a supplement to an Act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland at January Session, 1864, chapter 96, entitled an Act to incorporate the Liberty and New Windsor Turnpike Company in Frederick and Carroll counties.
