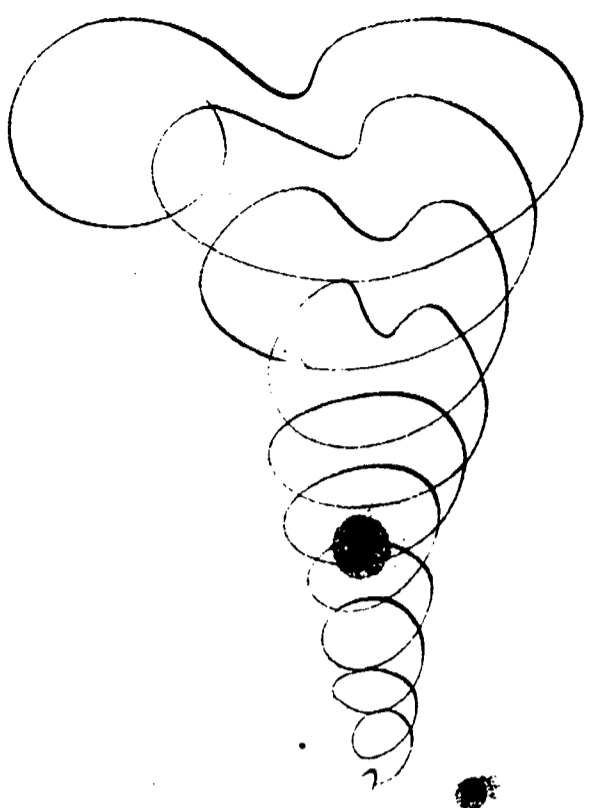

 summoned to answer unto John: Barron of the same County Esquire
 of a plea that he would unto him the full and just sum of four thousand
 pounds of good bright sound merchantable tobacco in Cash value to him
 he oweth and unjustly detineth &c.

And whereupon the said John: Barron by Peter South his Attorney saith that the said John: Rowell
 the 23. day of June in the year of our Lord 1689 at Memoran within the Jurisdiction of this County
 by his certain writing Obligatory, where the said John: Barron with the seal of the said John: Rowell
 signed brought his into Court, the date whereof is the day aforesaid, and he would bind himself
 himself to be bound to the said John: Barron in the full and just sum of four thousand pounds of tobacco
 and Cash, to his writing payment well and truly to be made: the said John: Rowell bound himself firmly to
 the said writing. Now the said sum of four thousand pounds of tobacco although often demanded the
 same to the said John: Barron hath not paid, but hath utterly refused, but hath utterly denied and
 doth still deny to the damage of the said John: Barron of 6000. pounds of tobacco & the loss of his bringing
 his suit &c. Court & Law.
