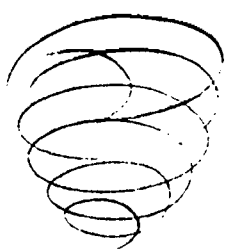

It was the following Bill presented in Court, with a receipt as follows

Know all men by these presents, that I James Barry of the County of Somerset and Province of Maryland

Canon my Heirs, Executors, Admin^{rs} am holden and firmly bound to pay or cause to be paid to Peter

Whaples of the same County and Province a fowse Cordwainer, his Heirs, Executors or Assigns or lawfull

Agent, the full and just quantity of fully six good slaughter hinds all to be shorn the One half to be upper

leather well tanned and Currid the other half to be sold leather to be paid at or before the last day of August

ensuing the date hereof being for a valuable consideration in hand made in witness whereof I have hereunto

set my hand and seal this first day of July Anno Domini 1689 James Barry. & Seal.

Know all men by these presents that I Peter Whaples of the County of Somerset and Province of Maryland

Cordwainer do hereby and bind my self and my Heirs, Executors Admin^{rs} to deliver or cause to be delivered to

James Barry his Heirs Executors, or Admin^{rs} the Obligation which James Barry hath passed to me dated June

the 1st 1689, or fully as the said obligation is in the said Obligation which James Barry hath passed to me dated June

the 1st 1689, or fully as the said obligation is in the said Obligation the full and entire quantity of twenty eight hinds in good Order according as is inscribed in the said Bond in witness whereof

Received of James Barry Heirson the sum of one hundred and a half pence upon the account of the Bill

Issued by me. Peter Whaples.

James Barry Esquire p^r Attorney m^r Jas. Danyls: and Edward Jones. the matter referred to judgment of the Court

where the Court having thoroughly considered the premises, and also the Case of Robert Catlin who made Case for the p^r cost

by that Peter Whaples would abate One hind to Barry in lieu of 200. of tobacco, and therefor the Court grants Order

ag^t to Barry for the remainder which is 13 1/2 hinds. and of tanned leather.

John Strawbridge p^r Edward Jones. Attorney was attached to answer unto John

Strawbridge in an action of the Case. And whereas the Bill doth appear in the

proper person and saith that the said Edward Jones doth detain and fraudulently

and unjustly keep from the p^r One servant woman named Mary Maxwell the

sum of the 17 day of July last past or thereabouts, thought of her demanded by the

p^r, without any just cause or reason, only the said Edward Jones doth insist

and fallaciously (alleging) that he made a swap with the p^r by letting the p^r have the burial of One Margaret Williams

servant to the said Edward Jones, who was a poor widow and unable to do any manner of service, she

having her death upon her when she came to the p^r, she kept her dead within 14 days after she came to the p^r and

within fifteen days a floor. Notwithstanding the p^r denyeth that there was any swap made at all, but an intended swap

which never was accomplished, and what was done was not to continue but until last August Court, unless the swap or thing

is perfected before the 30 August Court, wherefor the p^r saith, that he hath damages and is dammified to the value of 100
