But the deft fraudulently and craftily intending to deceive the pl. of the aforesaid sum of 1300^l. of tobacco & same hath lited to deny & yet doth deny to the pl. great loss & damage to the value of two thousand six hundred pounds of the said tobacco in Cash and thereupon brings this suit
