Newbold send greeting know ye that whereas there hath been and now is a Certain suite of Law depending  
in Somerset County Court agt Lawrence: Crawford and Sarah his wife Esquires of Court. Dns who doth  
at the suit of Francis: Jenkins: Gent for sundry goods and Merchandises by the sd Francis: Jenkins: lent and  
delivered to the sd Dns in his life time, and for the appoyning whereof the said parties have written and subscribed  
the said Stephen: Luff and Thomas: Newbold Arbitrators Indifferently betwixen them and so that and  
have bound them selves wither to either in the sum of twenty thousand pounds of tobacco, to stand to and abide  
the award Arbitrament and judgment of us remaining the premises. Now know ye that we the sd Stephen: Luff  
and Thomas: Newbold taking upon us the charge of the sd award, and minding that a final end & agreement shall  
be had and concluded betwixen the parties aforesd, concerning the premises, do declare that our award in manner of  
forms following. (viz) that the said Lawrence: Crawford. shall pay to the sd Francis: Jenkins: the  
severall particulars in a Certain account hereunto annexed (except those 600 lb) within the space of three years  
from the date hereof in the same species as received or as he can agree with the said Francis: Jenkins: and that the  
said Francis: Jenkins: allow him the said Lawrence: Crawford the sum of four hundred and thirtion pounds  
of tobacco out of the sd account as by the sd account appears and that each party pay their own charges in the  
said suite the said goods to be paid at these severall payments, and that we do declare to be the award & final  
determination of us the above sd Arbitrators, as with our hands and seals this 24 day of Febr: Anno Domini 1690
