Waller: Lane according to Order past last night, appeared in Court before the Justices. and being questioned for sundry abuses done and committed agt Mr. Francis Gouvis in Court last, for which the Court demanded of the said Lane if he were willing to come to tryall, whose answer was to the contrary. But the Court voted that the said Lane should come to speedy tryall and therefore Command was given to the Clerk to summon twelve good and lawfull men of this County, to trye the said Cause depending where was immediately performed

Waller: Lane } Somerset County Mr. Browne upon the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June last past in  
Francis Gouvis, then president of this County, sitting at this Court in  
Waller: Lane } in the County of this Ma<sup>ties</sup> then and there, the said Lane present in Court upon request  
a writ facias, agt John: Kirke, son of the Duke of Edward. Arden and called. in Waller: Lane  
neither party or sworn attorney, or not having produced any warrant under the said Kirke's hand, did  
then and there as so is, most grossly and importunately abuse and object agt the said president, being  
no ways provoked, did sturrolously assert in the face of Court, that the said John: Kirke had subre-  
-ptitiously obtained the above said writ facias, unto the said Gouvis did prove the legality of the same.  
The said Lane did then, with an audacious face, declare the following words, if it was done by the  
Gouvis, he must needs say it was lawfully done of the said Gouvis, which complaint abt the  
Substante was then returned. And the Complainant travs Order agt the said Lane, first for the  
abuse in interfering with the said writ facias between the complainant and the said Kirke's writ warranty  
secondly for interfering the Complainant with the writ facias and calling it in Court  
J. S. p. l.
