So their Majesties Justices of the Peace for Somerset County the humble petition of John: Sterling sheweth that whereas your petitioner was summoned for to attend this Court in June last as a Jury man, but your Petitioner being taken with a fever and being coming to Court and could not be there in time enough, so that your Petitioner was fined as in form, whereupon your Petitioner humbly prays, your worships would be pleased to remit the same and your Petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray John: Sterling

Petition granted and the fine remitted

Ordered by this Court that Philip: d'Almeida be Overseer in the town of Great: Hobbs in the County of Somerset.

Ordered likewise that the several respective Overseers in this County, do forthwith cause their Majesties High ways and Bridges to be amended throughout this County.

The Court adjourned to the next Tuesday in September: 1691

Thomas: Hebb of this County Taylor. came this day and requested that a Cow Calf might be returned for one John: Giff's Orphan Boy to one Elmer Giff, which said Orphan was given to the said Hebb by the said Elmer in Court. the said Calf now is given by the said Hebb to the said Giff with all its increase in presence of Thomas Hebb and his wife. and marked thus with a Croppon in right ear. and a Square bit taken out of the lepp of the left ear. which calf is called by the name of Fortune. entered this 26th day of 7th month. Anno Domini 1691.
