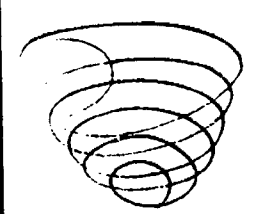


At a Court of Adjournment hold by their Majties Justices of the Peace for the County of Somerset in the
