having heard the forego Ffifteenth the examination of the said Jurors, as also the Oaths of John: Lemp. and

and Suits were agreed and this day by the 1st day of Oct 1691. The said Jury being referred in

their Malies £80 m^r & Mary Lucy Rydon of England or the sum of 60 t. Sterling money of England, due to be
paid on his goods and Chattels Lands and tenements for their Malies used or.*

*The Recd^r of this recognizance is true that if Judith wife of Robert Towne be of
the good Behaviour and assurance to all their Malies Lidge people of this Country during this Courts
pleasure as also make her personal appearance at our next County Court to answer to such matters & things as shall
be then & there ordered agt her that then to be about so recognizance to be good and of new effect otherwise to be
remain in full power force and vertue.*

said Robert in Open Court did confess himselfe to be justly indebted to their Malies in the sum of thirty
pounds Sterling money of England, and the said Lemp and Gold did likewise confess themselves indebted to
their Malies in the sum of thirty pounds a piece, all due to be paid on his goods & Chattels Lands & tenements
for their Malies used or.*

*The Recd^r of the above said recognizance is true that if the said Robert Towne be of the good
Behaviour and assurance to all their Malies Lidge people of this Country during this Courts pleasure, as also shall
make his personal appearance at our next County Court to be holden the 2^d Tuesday in November next to answer
to all such matters and things as shall be then & there ordered agt him on behalf of their Malies, that then to be
good & of new effect otherwise to be remain in full power & vertue.*

*Ordered. Likewise that John: Lemp give security for his appearance next Court answering to their Malies or.
Order likewise sherriffes custody till 20^r of Nov^r to be fully given. and and
whereupon came the said Lemp & his two servitors by Thomas Shurter & Ann Henderson & John Lemp did confess him
selfe & confessing he was indebted to their Malies in the sum of 20 t. Sterling money of England, and the said Shurter and
Henderson did likewise acknowledge them selves to be indebted to their Malies the sum of ten pounds like money to
be paid on their goods & Chattels Lands & tenements for their Malies used or.*
